Airflow S Summit 2023 We organize and produce in person, online and hybrid **global** events like Airflow Summit, Beam Summit, IstioCon.



We start with speakers invitation and content coordination, legal entity for managing sponsors and subcontracting vendors.



We also manage the event's production and promotion as well as attendees management, registration and streaming. We finish with post-event video editing and promotion.



### Hackathons

We have organized more than 30 hackathons for enterprise customers as well as government institutions and communities.

Our involvement consists in: defining challenges and a strategy based on the target, be the first point of contact for participants, managing sponsorships and relationships with partners and sponsors, managing selection of winners and delivering prizes.

Among our signature hackathons is the global "Hackathon BBVA" which we produce annually for BBVA, one of the largest banks in the world. This is the largest corporate hackathon for spanish speaking developers.


